Warm Up

The venue will have three courts for warm up in the same competition venue. The priority will be for the players who play in the next time slot.

Bibs

BIBS:

The LOC will give two bibs to each player.

- One of the pieces must be worn all times during the hours of competition. The competitor number must be affixed on the front of the shirt or the trouser leg.
- The second competitor number is a reserve copy.

Call Room

Prior to entering the Warm Up Area and Call Room, players, coaches and sport Assistants must ensure that they have their Accreditation Tag with them. Bibs should be clearly visible.

The call room will open 30 minutes before the official time, and will close 15 minutes before the match.

The assistants of the players and all material, must be in the call room at the same time that the player.

6	Positive Points Difference in a Single Match	The highest positive points difference (points scored, minus points conceded) in a single match in descendint order.
7	Positive Points Difference in a Single End	The highest positive points difference (points scored, minus points conceded) in a single end in descendint order.

Protests Procedures

PROTESTS AND APPEALS:

All claims will be, in the first instance, to the Head Referee.

Upon the decision taken by the Head Referee will be entitled to claim the Jury of Appeal. Claims made to the Jury of Appeal shall be made in writing, no later than 30 minutes after the decision of the Referee and accompanied by €30, to the Competition Director. A copy of the decision of the Jury of Appeal will be made public on the Results Board.
